All interviewees pointed out the lack of business counseling easily accessible for immigrants. As the best practice of working with such target group, individual counseling considering special needs and requirements of a concrete person was named. They all would appreciate better exchange of experiences, concepts and contents of courses focused on social-cultural aspects. In comparison to other clients, immigrants need special assistance and detailed instructions in the process of opening a business. Both trainers and social workers provide them not only with information on legal framework and socio-cultural differences, but also with special assistance in attending to certain documents, licences and permits needed.
